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



OUR VENUE

Q: Do you have more than one wedding ceremony on the same day?

A: Here at Shortflatt Tower we want you to share your love, not your special day! When you book your wedding with us, you will have exclusive use of the entirety of our 65 acre estate comprising of our 800 year old Tower, Manor house, Walled gardens, Courtyard cottages, Paddock, Woodland suite and more!

Q: What are your minimum numbers and pre-spend required to hire Shortflatt Tower?

A: Whatever your budget, we will create the perfect package for you to ensure your day with us is a dream come true. Please see our pricing quide for more details in regards to our requirements or ask one of our amazing wedding coordinators.

O: What is the maximum number of attendees you allow for a wedding?

A: Our Woodland Suite can comfortably accommodate up to 160 quests for your ceremony and wedding breakfast. For your evening, we can accommodate a maximum of 250 guests.

Q: I have now booked my wedding at Shortflatt Tower, what is the role of my wedding coordinator?

A: Your dedicated wedding coordinator is there to organise all in-house aspects of your big day between booking your wedding right up until the day. Your wedding coordinator will look after all food and drink requirements, timings & flow of the day, additional extras, and advice regarding external suppliers. All members of our lovely wedding team have a wealth of knowledge and experience and are all always on hand to answer any questions you may have, no matter how small or silly they may seem – you are in safe hands.

Q: How often can I meet with my wedding coordinator?

A: We are always here for you! Pick up the phone 01661 520 210 or send us an email at weddings@shortflatttower.com. You can also make an appointment to come and see us as many times as you wish. Whether its to help choosing your room allocations, deciding on food and drink options, running through your day and just need reassurance with your wedding planning and suppliers. We are here! We

will book you in for your final run through of your day around 6 weeks prior to your wedding, where all aspects of your big day is covered!

Q: Do you allow marguees or bouncy castles?

A: We have beautifully manicured lawns and we would hate for them to be damaged therefore we don't allow any structures (marguees or bouncy castles) on our lawns. We have some fun outdoor lawn games you can hire from which are available on our additional extras list.

Q: Do you have a list of recommended suppliers to help me plan my day?

A: We have a fantastic list of suppliers which we can recommend you. All of who are familiar with the layout of Shortflatt tower estate. We have no financial ties with our suppliers, but we love their high quality of services they offer couples.

Q: What options do guests have for transport if not staying on site after the wedding?

A: We recommend pre-booking taxis whenever possible. Most Newcastle firms will travel to us and Darras & Pont Taxis are a very close local firm. When booking transport for your quests, please avoid full size/large buses. They sadly will not fit over our stunning Grade II listed bridge that welcomes you into the estate.

Q: Can I bring my dog?

A: Yes absolutely, your furry family friend is welcome to join in your celebrations! Dogs are not permitted to stay in the main house; however, one dog is permitted per cottage. Please note there is an additional cleaning charge of £15.00 per dog.

FAQ's

ACCOMMODATION

Q: How many bedrooms are there available to us at Shortflatt Tower the night of our wedding? A: There are 15 Bedrooms in the Tower and annex, sleeping 30 people. Our 6 cottages range from 2 bed to 5 Beds. The total amount we can sleep is 71 quests (75 including z beds for children), however couples are only required to take 15 bedrooms on the night of the wedding (including the complimnetary Bridal Suite). Continental breakfast is included in the price and is available in each of the properties fully stocked kitchens. You can self-check into rooms from 4pm.

Q: How many bedrooms do we need to book on the night of our wedding?

A: We do ask that a minimum number of 15 bedrooms are taken in the Manor House, including the complimentary Bridal Suite. Cottages can be reserved and added on prior to the Contract being issued. Please see our Pricing Guide for more details or ask your wedding coordinator.

O: What time is check in?

A: Check in is 4pm. If you are staying on-site with us, we will send you an email detailing the location of your allocated bedroom and we operate on a self-check-in system, your key will be in your bedroom door ready for you with no need to report to a reception! There will also be members of the wedding team available to assist with check in on the day too.

Q: What time is check out the day after our wedding?

A: Check out is 10am. Please make sure you take all your belongings.

Q: Can we stay on-site the night before our wedding?

A: YES, We have Fullerton Cottage which is available to the Bride and her party from 4pm the night before, priced at £695.00. There are 3 bedrooms which can be doubles or twin beds. Open plan living room and kitchen with a continental breakfast. You also get the use of our steam room, lie under the twinkling lights relaxing before your big day. You have a separate entrance from the bottom car park so no interference from any other quests. We also have six (2-5 bed) cottages sleeping 35 which may also be available. Our in-house culinary team will feed you and your guests and provide a drinks package for the evening. To guarantee Fullerton and additional cottages, please speak to us before the Contract is issued.

Q: My guests aren't staying the night prior; can they get ready on site?

A: We advise your guests arrive ready, as they would a church wedding. On arrival their luggage can be stored and tagged, and our housekeeping team will place bags in their rooms while guests enjoy your celebrations prior to 4pm check-in.

Q: Do you have a car park?

A: Yes, we ample car parking space. Two car parks out of site and the main car park in front of the tower, with a capacity of approximately 40 cars. We aim to keep cars away from the Tower entrance, this area is reserved for the marital couple to park and to get their photographs taken. We ask everyone to park courteously and as close as possible to each other. We do have overflow car park on the paddock (weather depending)

Q: Does your venue/accommodation have disability access?

A: The Tower does have a few steps up to the main entrance. We have a ramp on-site to accommodate any guests attending in a wheelchair. The Woodland View function space is entirely accessible and has a disabled toilet. We also have ground floor accommodation available in five of our on-site cottages. Please discuss any accessibility questions with your wedding co Ordinator to make sure everybody is looked after by our team.

Q: Do you provide z beds and cots for children?

A: Yes, z beds can be provided for under 12s but only in the larger bedrooms. These are priced at £50 per bed inclusive of breakfast. Travel cots can be provided free of charge.





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CEREMONY

Q: Is it possible to get married outside?

A: We have beautiful walled gardens and lawns with to choose from for your perfect setting! We make a wet weather plan just in-case the outside ceremony plans can't go ahead. In which case we would move the ceremony inside the woodland suite.

Q: Do you supply a Master of Ceremonies?

A: Yes! As part of your package a member of the SFT will be happy to be master of ceremonies. Why not get your Family members involved, brother, ushers or Bridesmaids!

Q: Do I need to book a registrar and what time should I opt for? Who do I contact for this?

A: Once you have a date on hold with us, you need to contact the registrar. They will confirm that there is a registrar available to marry you and at what time. The Earliest ceremony time we can host is 12pm. To check availability please contact the Northumberland Registrars directly on 01665 602870. Please let us know as soon as you have booked your registrar and then we can start planning your day!

O: What time should I get married?

A: If getting married on site, we advise booking the 1.30pm ceremony slot with Northumberland Registrar Team or with your chosen Celebrant / Humanist. If you are marrying off-site/having a church ceremony, please allow a little longer for the service and travel time. We advise around 12.00pm or 12.30pm for a church ceremony. However, if you would prefer a different ceremony time, please chat to our wedding team so we can plan your order of the day accordingly.

Q: How much do the registrars charge? Do I pay them directly?

A: You need to contact and pay Northumberland County Council and pay an initial £45 non-refundable booking fee then the remaining ceremony fees range from £395-£495 dependant on the day of the week and year. Please contact the Northumberland Registrars on 01665 602 870 for an accurate guotation.

Q: What time should we ask our guests to arrive for?

A: We advise asking guests to arrive at least 1 hour prior to your ceremony to allow them to meet in the Tower, it also allows them time to get a pre-ceremony refreshment from the Annex courtyard bar.

Q: Can we play our own music during the ceremony and wedding breakfast?

A: Absolutely, you choose your songs!! Make a playlist on Spotify or save it on an iPad and we can play your special songs. If you want live music we can recommended a harpist, bands, drums etc. on our suppliers list who can entertain you and all your guests throughout the day.

Q: How many tracks should the ceremony music include?

A: We recommend 5 for pre-ceremony, 1 for walking down the aisle, 3 for signing the register and 1 more for your exit song. We do also recommend your track for walking down the aisle is a minimum of 3 minutes long. We can also play our wedding music for you if you are happy for us to do so during your signing and for your guests arriving and leaving the ceremony room.

O: Can we throw confetti?

A: Yes of course you can! Fantastic photo opportunity! Please ensure all confetti is biodegradable and 100% natural.

FAQ's

FOOD & DRINK

Q: What food options do you offer?

A: We have a fantastic menu for you to choose from, whether you want traditional 3 courses, canapés, sharing boards, BBQ's, International cuisines and a great choice of evening buffet food. There is something for everyone to choose from, also catering for any dietary requests.

Q: How long does a typical wedding breakfast take?

A: We allow anything from 2-3 hours depending on guest numbers and food choices. Please discuss this with your wedding coordinator before invites are sent out so we can get timings an accurate as possible.

Q: Can I offer my guests a choice of dishes?

A: We recommend you offer 2 dishes per course to guest for your wedding breakfast, this is to make sure the smooth running of food service. We can of course cater for any veggie dishes or special dietary requirements separately.

Q: I am thinking of having a BBQ or sharing boards instead of a three course wedding breakfast, can I taylor my menu choice?

A: We want to allow you as much possible freedom with your food choices. There are various options to choose from or additional courses to add on, canapés and amuse bouche!! If you have something in mind for your food and it's not on our menu. Please discuss this with us and we will price it up with our chefs.

Q: Do you allow outside catering or corkage?

A: No. Please note this also includes alcoholic items used as favours.

Q: Is it necessary to cater for all of our evening guests?

A: All evening quests must be catered for, its hungry work working up an appetite on the dance floor!!

Q: Do you cater to dietary requirements?

A: Please let us know on your table plan and food choice forms any special dietary requests. We will make sure everybody gets fed their appropriate meal choices. All food choices must be complete by 6 weeks prior to your wedding day.

Q: Do you have a cake knife and cake stand that we can use?

A: Yes, we have a round or square silver cake stand, or a wooden stand, along with a silver knife. These can be added onto to your final invoice if required.

Q: What time will the bar close on our wedding night? A: On a week day: 12.00am. On a weekend: 1am.

ROOM DECORATION & SET-UP

Q: What is included in terms of the table set-up?

A: All crockery, cutlery, glassware is included in your package. Any centre pieces, runners or place mats would need to be sourced from elsewhere.

If you keep it simple, we can place name places and favours. However, if you require more table dressing, we can recommend a supplier to do this for you. If you want to do this yourself if must be booked in with your wedding planner.

Q: What is the maximum amount that can be seated per table for the wedding breakfast?

A: For your top table, we can seat a max of 10 guests. Our round tables can also accommodate a max of 10 guests. Please note these numbers include any children and high chairs.



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Q: How long does the room turnaround after the ceremony, before the wedding breakfast take and where do guests congregate during this time?

A: It takes around 1½ hours to turn the room around during which we invite guests for reception drinks in the annex courtyard and canapés; this is also a great opportunity to take photographs and walk round the gardens and house!

Q: Do you supply table linen and napkins?

A: Yes, we supply white napkins and cloths if desired; however, our beautiful rustic wooden tables, look stunning without any table cloths. White table cloths are priced at £15 per table.

Q: Do you supply high chairs?

A: Yes. We also have baby changing facilities in the woodland suite and free travel cots (please provide your own linen for baby).

Q: Do you allow candles in your venue and grounds?

A: We do not allow any naked flames, however a popular, safer alternative is LED tea-lights, which are very effective and provide a very natural effect.

Q: Can we bring our own decorations and props?

A: Absolutely! We want you to have your wedding, your way, please feel free to drop off anything you want included in the set-up of your day, the night before your wedding is planned to take place.

Alternatively, if you are looking to hire any items, you can ask your coordinator for our 'Additional Extras' list such as Royal Mail Post-box, Garden Games, fire pits, chair ties and runners etc.

If you are looking for an 'event stylist' please refer to our recommended suppliers list.

Q: We are aware we need to supply our own stationary, but do you have anything we can display our Table Plan on?

A: Yes! We have a beautiful easel. We recommend your table plan to be no smaller than A2 or no larger than A1 (portrait).

Q: When do our suppliers come in and dress the room?

A: Your suppliers can have access to the Function Suite from 8am, however our team will happily set your place cards and favours if you drop them off the night before, please let us know what time you will do this. Please speak with your coordinator with regards to set up of any additional decorations. Please note, all fresh flowers and cakes must be delivered on the day of your wedding.

ENTERTAINMENT

Q: Can we provide our own band and DJ? Can they use your PA system?

A: Yes, of course you can have your own DJ or Band. All bands and DJs must be self contained with Public Liability Insurance and provide their own PAT tested electrical equipment. Please refer to our list of recommended suppliers for details of bands and DJs you may find useful.

Q: Do you have disco lights?

A: There are no fixed disco lights, however you are more than welcome to bring your own providing these are PAT tested.

Q: How long does the room turnaround after the ceremony, before the wedding breakfast take and where do guests congregate during this time?

A: It takes around 1½ hours to turn the room around during which we invite guests for reception drinks in the annex courtyard and canapés; this is also a great opportunity to take photographs and walk round the gardens and house!

PAYMENT

Q: How can I pay my £1,000 non-refundable deposit?

A: If you are ready to confirm your big day with us, we can provisionally hold a date deposit-free for up to 7 working days. We then require a £1,000 non-refundable deposit to secure the date (please note: this is non-refundable or transferable, and don't foraet to book your registrar first!). Your wedding is only confirmed when we receive a signed copy of your contract.

Q: What is your payment plan after my initial deposit?

A: Payments are spread out for you; 25% instalments are due 9 months & 6 months before your wedding day with the remaining 50% of your final balance due 1 month prior to your big day, in conjunction with your final guest numbers.

Q: Can I pay via BACS?

A: Yes, of course. Please ask your wedding coordinator for our details.
